Baylight '24 attracted more than 28,000 attendees, bringing a vibrant atmosphere to Morecambe during the winter season.

Our social media presence has grown by 30% each year, reaching a potential audience of over 200,000 individuals across various platforms.

The Festival has generated substantial media coverage, with features in local and regional newspapers, TV and radio broadcasts, and digital outlets.

- 95% said they would like to come to another, similar event in Morecambe in future and 94% would also recommend the event to others

A superb return on investment

- With an average spend per person of over £16, hundreds of thousands of pounds were spent in Morecambe at both Baylights
- The total economic impact of Baylight '24 is estimated at £905,075, 11% up on 2023
- For every £1 of grant invested in the events, over £3 was generated for the local economy

A series of colourful LED lights along the roofline of the Midland Hotel, creating a stunning, flowing effect. With two bold searchlights beaming into the sky, designed to catch the eye and bring extra excitement to the event.



We're adding a fun twist with interactive stepping stones! Each step lights up and makes a sound, inviting visitors to play along. To make it even better, we'll add a splash of colourful light across the whole area, creating a vibrant, playful atmosphere for everyone to enjoy.





Rainbow Flow Luminism

Bright, colourful batons line one side of the path, pulsing with rainbow lights in a wave-like motion that guides visitors along. This flowing effect mirrors the bay's natural rhythm, creating an immersive experience that

celebrates the beauty and energy of light and water.



Reflections of Morecambe Luminism

Local legend has it that the Disco Ball was invented in Morecambe in the 1920s! This installation plays with that memory and honours the historic Winter Gardens, Morecambe's beloved dancehall. A stunning mirrorball, inspired by the original "Kaleidoscopic Globe" sits proudly on the balcony, reflecting beams of light that dance across the facade in a magical display.



Kinetic Light Luminism

In the centre of the semi-circular lawn, a stunning new light sculpture will take the spotlight. This large, twisting piece creates a feeling of constant motion, with brightly coloured blades that stand out against surrounding lights. It's a mesmerising, ever-evolving display and the perfect centrepiece to captivate visitors.



Bubble Tubes Luminism

Our giant interactive bubble towers are perfect for families. This set of six bubble tubes lets visitors control the colours with a light-up panel, creating endless combinations. Fun, hands-on, and a bright highlight along the trail.



Biolluminate

Local Artist - Mortlock Arts

Biolluminate is a multimedia hydroponic light installation that collaborates with local communities to grow edible plants. 70% of the plants are donated to food banks and participants, while the remaining 30% are used in the installation itself, creating a sustainable cvcle.



Chainballs

Local Artist - Pangus

Local artist Paul Angus returns with his evolving Chainballs, but bigger and brighter for 25. These unique sculptures turn recycled materials into striking orbs of light in different sizes. Inspired by themes of shadow and strength, each orb glows from within, creating captivating light patterns and textures that invite visitors to pause, look closer, and reflect.





A stunning light and sound installation with towering, six-metre "light trees" that respond to soothing music inspired by the Fibonacci sequence. The LED lights flow in real-time with the music, creating endless, colourful patterns that never repeat, offering a peaceful, absorbing experience.





Moby Dick Local Artist - Richard Ryan

A full-size 2D recreation of Morecambe's legendary "Moby Dick", a ship which tragically burned in 1970. Originally built as the schooner "Ryelands", it starred in the film "Treasure Island", where Robert Newton coined the famous pirate saying, "Arr, Jim lad!" This loving tribute brings the iconic ship back to life near its original mooring spot.





Watch the hugely popular parade weaving its way along Marine Road Central to the sound of local groups including Baybeat and Samba Espirito.





Our Community Programme invites everyone to get involved in creating light art for the big parade. Through hands-on workshops, participants can work with local artists, learn new skills and craft pieces to show off in the parade. It's a great way to celebrate Morecambe's creativity and support local talent while lighting up the town together.


















Luminism

This eye-catching installation is a 3.5m tall structure made of 140 light tubes, designed to look like a 3D Rubik's Cube. It runs hypnotic patterns and textures across every angle, creating a striking visual that's perfect for drawing people in and making them pause to enjoy the show.

Journey to the Centre of the Kingdom

Local Artist - Shane Johnstone

To celebrate Morecambe Bay as the geographical centre of the UK, we're creating an illuminated labyrinth. Unlike a maze, it's a winding path that leads to the centre and back, perfect for a reflective journey. At the heart a Vegas-inspired arch will welcome visitors with a flashing "BINGO" sign, and the exact grid reference - a glitzy, fun tribute.
